SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
Snow Emergency
January 31, 2014

A special meeting of the Scott Town Board was held Friday, January 31, 2014 at the Scott Town Hall. Chairman Peterson, Supervisor Lundberg and Clerk Wiggins were present. A quorum being present, the meeting was called to order at 1:10 p.m. Also present was Doug McCreadie, Scott Assistant Fire Chief and Rick Larson, Road Supervisor.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and meeting notice postings verified.

DISCUSSION AND ACTION

Discussion was held regarding safety and physical access for first responders as they respond to emergency calls this winter with poor road conditions and the heavy amount of snow. It was agreed that the town board will call in personnel and equipment (road crew and fire department) as needed. (Tim McConnell, an EMT for North Memorial, joined the meeting for approximately 30 minutes.)

At the 2014 Annual Meeting of the Taxpayers, the town board will reiterate the necessity for property owners to make their property accessible for emergency responders through the year.

Supervisor Lundberg, first responder liaison, will meet with the EMS First Responders and EMTs to review responding during bad weather conditions.

A joint meeting will be set up with the Scott Fire Department, Webb Lake Area First Responders and EMTs to discuss the role each organization plays as first responders.

The meeting adjourned at 2:03 p.m.
