Resolution R2013-04

WHEREAS, the black bear population of the northwestern region of Wisconsin is high and is increasing; and,

WHEREAS, the black bear population and their documented contact with people, domesticated animals, farm animals and property has proven dangerous and is a great concern;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT it is necessary that the black bear population be reduced in the near future; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT the Department of Natural Resources take necessary actions required to reduce, and then monitor, the black bear population in the northwestern region of Wisconsin in order to protect the safety and welfare of the people and communities.

This resolution takes effect upon passage and posting in three (3) public places in the township.
