Supervisor McIntyre called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call: Chairperson Jeff McIntyre, Supervisor John Vanous, Supervisor Bill Sobaski, Treasurer Carol Jacobson, Fire Chief Doug McCreadie and Clerk Ken Busby were present. Meeting notice postings were verified.

**AGENDA** Motion (Sobaski/Vanous) to approve the agenda order as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

**REPORTS, DISCUSSION and ACTION**

**2019 Budget Workshop:** McCreadie- Fire Department will be running close on wages due to the number of people in classes. A need to buy about \$18,000 in new air tanks still. Continue to allocate money for a new fire truck in 2025. Repeat budget from 2018 to 2019.

Jacobson- \$800 mileage, \$750 in postage, training and travel is fine. Laptop possible. Busby thought \$450 would cover a good laptop.

Clerk's office is good. Decrease in phone expense by \$600. Leaving the other amounts should be good. Only two elections next year, decrease election wages budget to \$1200.

Highway- Increase pay for hourly employees, maybe 50 cents per hour, should be about \$3500/yr increase. Eye wash station. Change out fluorescent lights to LED. Pay for cleaning the town hall hourly at \$25. Various discussions on future equipment desires. Helicopter pad at Voyager and road leading up to it discussion. Road paving needs.
