Supervisor McIntyre called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call: Chairperson Jeff McIntyre, Supervisor John Vanous, Supervisor Bill Sobaski, Treasurer Carol Jacobson, Fire Chief Doug McCreadie and Clerk Ken Busby were present. Meeting notice postings were verified.

**AGENDA** Motion (Sobaski/Vanous) to approve the agenda order as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

**REPORTS, DISCUSSION and ACTION**

**County Highway Department Request:** The county desires to store some salt/sand on our property and keep a front-end loader on our property for winter logistics. McIntyre expressed support for this as it will help in keeping our area highways clear. Sobaski and Vanous expressed support. The question arose if they allow the town to use the equipment and sand/salt. This appears to be acceptable.

**Town of Scott Fire Engine:** McCreadie proposed for the 2024 fire engine replacement to possibly do it now. The price has gone up \$100k since last Engine was purchased in 1999 (\$157,000). There is an anticipated a 4%/year increase with tariffs and inflation. Financing interest could be as low as 1%, but will need to check. Current Engine has value for trade-in.

**2019 Budget Workshop:** Filled in Waste/Recycling, \$65,000 for a dedicated mower and some revenue items that are in our control.
