**CANNOT RECYCLE** Alkaline batteries, Automotive product containers, Brush, “Bubble” wrap, Coated paper on which labels are adhered, Logs, Propane / Helium tanks and Liquids, Plastic Bags, Shredded Paper, Styrofoam (includes egg cartons) and Tarps.

### **RECYCLABLE HOUSEHOLD ITEMS**

*No need to sort or separate these items*

~~~~**RECYCLING CONTAINERS FOR THESE ITEMS ARE RESTRICTED TO USE BY HOUSEHOLDS ONLY; NO BUSINESS GENERATED RECYCLING IS ACCEPTED**~~~~

Aluminum / Tin / Steel – Food grade cans, MUST BE CLEAN; can leave labels on cans. No scrap metal in bins.

Cardboard – All cardboard including corrugated and waxed. **Exception:** no cardboard with food stains. Please break down ALL boxes to help conserve space.

Glass – MUST BE CLEAN and remove ALL caps; can leave labels on item. Unacceptable: ceramics, clay pots, drinking glasses or dishes, light bulbs, mirror or window glass, ovenware or crystal.

Newspaper and Inserts, Magazines and Catalogs, Junk Mail, Envelopes, Cardboard, Office and School Paper, Phone Books, Brown Paper Sacks, Bags – Please keep paper dry, and do not tie with twine, string or other materials.

Paper Products – Rinsed waxed paper beverage/food containers, magazines, paper bags, glossy advertising, inserts and catalogs, all types of clean office and school paper, post-it notes, junk mail and phone books. Staples and window envelopes are acceptable, no paper clips, metal, cloth or plastic bindings. *Please note that tissue paper, paper towels, food-contaminated paper, paper plates and styrofoam are not acceptable under any category; i.e. no pizza boxes or aluminum foil.*

Plastics – Numbers 1, 2 and 5 are accepted. MUST BE CLEAN; can leave labels on item. Absolutely NO automotive product bottles regardless of number classification.
