BOARD MEETING MINUTES

February 12, 2024, 7:00 PM

Chairperson Scott Barton called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call: Chairperson Scott Barton, Supervisor Deni Olson, Supervisor John Vanous, Treasurer Paul Kipping and Clerk Ken Busby were present. Busby stated the agenda was posted at the A&H Country Market Bulletin Board, outside the town hall door in the glass cabinet and on the town website on February 7, 2024.

AGENDA ORDER – Motion (Olson/Vanous) to accept the agenda order. Motion carried 3-0.

CONSIDER QUOTES FOR SALT SHED CONSTRUCTION – No other bids received other than last month bid from Northland Builders. Need to check if the dollar amount exceeds the amount needed to publish bid requests. Motion (Barton/Vanous) to accept the bid from Northland Builders. Motion carried 3-0.

APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY CLERK – Clerk Busby will be out of town for the February election. Gail Sobaski was appointed temporary Deputy Clerk for the election.

FIRE CHIEF REPORT: Chief Brian Ohmann reported, pretty quiet. Bylaws state that if there is a change, it needs to be approved by the town board. Fire Department voted to eliminate the position of President. Motion (Olson/Vanous) to approve the change in the Fire Department bylaws.

TOWN ROADS REPORT: Brushing, shouldering. Burning brush at the recycle center. Roger at the Town of Jackson was looking to borrow our grapple. Maybe use their boom mower in exchange. The board was receptive to the idea. Towns need to inventory their culverts. A class to help do this is coming up.

RECYCLING CENTER REPORT: Vanous reported that the compactor is working. Solar company did some adjustments and it is working even better.

CHAIRMAN REPORT: Barton asked who approves billboards. The county does all the permits for this.
