BOARD MEETING MINUTES
Scott Town Hall
June 10, 2024, 7:00 PM

Chairperson Scott Barton called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call: Chairperson Scott Barton, Supervisor John Vanous, Treasurer Paul Kipping and Clerk Ken Busby were present. Supervisor Deni Olson was unable to attend. Busby stated the agenda was posted at the A&H Country Market Bulletin Board, outside the town hall door in the glass cabinet and on the town website on June 5, 2024.

AGENDA ORDER – Motion (Vanous/Barton) to accept the agenda order. Motion carried 2-0.

MINUTES – Motion (Vanous/Barton) to approve the May 13, 2024 Monthly Board Meeting minutes. Motion carried 2-0.

FINANCIAL REPORTS – May 2024 Financial Statements were presented.

PUBLIC COMMENT – County Supervisor, Emily Gall said the ADRC is trying to get a central kitchen. Melinda Boyum asked about sweeping intersections. Vanous it was in progress. Boyum asked if there is a schedule and is interested in Hill Road. Vanous said there is not schedule, it is as the weather allows. Boyum asked if a schedule can be made. Barton said he is starting weekly meetings with the road crew and will mention it this week. Question asked about the budget for equipment? Vanous said the intention is a new dump truck, but that has now been postponed at least a year. Question of if the budget can be carried over or is it reallocated? The answer is yes to both.

LIQUOR LICENSE APPROVALS – Busby presented the list of establishments as published in the newspaper for the board to approve. Kipping stated that all the establishments are up to date on their tax bills. Motion (Vanous/Barton) to approve the list of establishment liquor licenses. Motion carried 2-0.

FIRE CHIEF REPORT: Chief Ohmann reported, the BBQ Rib Cookoff was fun for all. Even received a \$5000 donation from a family. There was one call for a missing person that was found by someone in our department.

TOWN ROADS REPORT: Barton reported the board is meeting with the roads crew once per week. Meeting last week had one employee.

RECYCLING CENTER REPORT: Vanous reported the Recycle Center is open Sundays now. We have a good bunch of workers. Question from a property owner, can cards start being taken? Vanous said he could look into it, but that it did not work in the past.

CHAIRMAN REPORT: Barton is moving into the roads aspect. Cold patch needs warmer weather. Investigating buying a heat plate to warm the patch for better adhesion.

VOUCHER APPROVAL / REJECTION, REVIEW AND PAYMENT OF CLAIMS: Motion (Olson/Vanous) to approve the vouchers. Motion carried 3-0.
