BOARD MEETING MINUTES

November 11, 2024, 7:00 PM

Chairperson Scott Barton called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call: Chairperson Scott Barton, Supervisor Deni Olson, Supervisor John Vanous, Deputy Treasurer Trisha Johnson and Clerk Ken Busby were present. RECYCLING CENTER REPORT: Vanous reported compactor not working, but working on fixing it. Things have slowed down. Throwing the garbage into the 30 yard containers until the compactor is fixed.

COUNTY SUPERVISOR REPORT: None.

CHAIRMAN REPORT: – Barton reported, the town hired a new guy that is working out great. The shop is looking good. Equipment is looking good. Still want to buy a new mowing tractor. Still want to write a letter regarding the Kilkare and Hanscom property and the illegal driveway. Peck property on Long Lake and Kilkare as well.
