BOARD MEETING MINUTES
Scott Town Hall
October 13, 2025, 7:00 PM

Chairperson Scott Barton called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call: Chairperson Scott Barton, Supervisor John Vanous, Supervisor Rob Bauman, Treasurer Trisha Johnson and Clerk Ken Busby were present. Busby stated the agenda was posted at the A&H Country Market Bulletin Board, the Town website and outside the town hall door in the glass cabinet on the October 8, 2025.

AGENDA ORDER – Motion (Vanous/Bauman) to approve the agenda order. Motion carried 3-0.

FINANCIAL REPORTS – September 2025 Financial Statements were presented.

FIRE CHIEF REPORT: Chief Ohmann was not present. Busby reported that there was a mutual aid call to Spooner, but were cancelled prior to getting to the scene.

TOWN ROADS REPORT: Supervisor Bauman and Road Boss John Meagher reported things are going well, working hard. Working on the canopy. About 90% of the roads are cut back. Shouldering work. Barton said he finished the road inspections.

RECYCLING CENTER REPORT: Supervisor Bauman reported the Boy Scouts came and got the aluminum cans.

COUNTY SUPERVISOR REPORT: Not present

CHAIRMAN REPORT: Barton said he was going to write two letters. The driveway issue on Hanscom Lake Road and neighbor across the street will be informed he cannot use Kilcare.
